6. Vidyadeep Scheme

The State Government has introduced this scheme in memory of the student who died in earthquake on 26th January, 2001. Vidyadeep Yojna, the Insurance scheme adopted children where the premium is paid by the Government for financial relief to parents on accidental death of students. The scheme provides protection of round the clock insurance to the students studying in the Government Primary Schools, Grant-in-aid primary schools, Ashram Schools, secondary and higher secondary schools. Insurance cover to be provided in primary school i.e. Rs. 50,000/- and secondary and Higher – Secondary schools Rs. 50000/-

7. Scholarships for Female Sportspersons

To promote young & talented sports women and prepare excellent players, from the inception of this scheme in 1999-2000, the quantum of cash scholarship has been increasing year to year. Under the scheme those girls who ranked 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the State competitions organised by the Commissioner of Youth Services and those who have participated in the SGFI National tournament, National Women Championship, All India Rural Sports will be eligible to get scholarship. The quantum of cash scholarships is Rs.4800, Rs.3600 and Rs.2400 for the rankers and Rs.4800 for national participants per year.

On March 8th 2008, 651 women participants & winners were given Rs.29.23 lakhs as scholarship.
