CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

NO- GP-2016(5) / ICD-102011-4256-B:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat here by makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Child Development Project Officer (Female), Class II, in the General State Service, under the Commissionerate of Woman and Child Development, Gujarat State, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Child Development Project Officer (Female), Class II, in the General State Service, under the Commissionerate of Women and Child Development, Gujarat State, Recruitment Rules, 2016.
2. Appointment to the post of Child Development Project Officer (Female), Class II, in the General State Service, under the Commissionerate of Women and Child Development, Gujarat State, shall be made, either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who,-
 - (i) have, worked for not less than-seven years in the cadre of Mukhya Sevika (Supervisor), Class III, in the Panchayat Service,
 - (ii) have passed the departmental examination prescribed by the Government.
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006, and
 - (iv) possess bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified in sub clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two- thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. The appointments by direct selection and promotion shall be made in the ratio of 1:4.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall, -
(a) not be more than 38 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned;

(b) possess, -

(i) a bachelor's degree in Home Science or Sociology or Child Development or Nutrition or Social Work obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and have about three years' experience in the field of Integrated Child Development in the Government or Local Bodies or Government Undertaking Board or Corporation or Limited Company established under the Companies Act, 2013 or University or registered Non-Government Organisation on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Mukhya Sevika, Class III recognised by the Government, or

(ii) a master's degree in Home Science or Sociology or Child Development or Nutrition or Social Work obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956,

(c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during her probation period, require to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during her probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall require to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
